

THE SURPRISING TRUTH ABOUT HEAVEN

with Dr. Michael Youssef

What inspired you to explore the study of Heaven and the afterlife?

MY: I find that few Christians spend much time thinking about Heaven or preparing for Heaven. I suppose that's because thinking about Heaven means thinking about dying—and we tend to avoid thinking about that! We're busy with our family and church activities and our business life, so we tell ourselves, "I don't have time to think about Heaven today. Maybe later." But Heaven is a core truth of our faith. If you trust in Jesus, why wouldn't you want to learn everything you can about the beauty and blessings of the place where you will spend eternity? Heaven is the fulfillment of all our deepest longings. As Solomon wrote in Ecclesiastes, God has set eternity in our hearts! I wrote this book to stir a hunger for eternity in the heart of every reader. I pray it will energize believers to live in light of the reality of Heaven.

What biblical teachings do you draw upon to illuminate the nature of Heaven and its significance for believers?

MY: The Bible discloses many exciting truths about Heaven. Here are three:

First, Heaven will be a place of face-to-face communion and fellowship with Jesus. In 1 Corinthians 13:12, Paul tells us, "For now we see only a reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face." We will be in a face-to-face relationship with Jesus and with God the Father. We shall experience eternal reality as it truly is.

Second, Heaven will be a place of rest from our spiritual battles. Revelation 14:13 tells us that believers in Heaven "will rest from their labor." We will have rest from the ceaseless spiritual struggles of this life.

Third, Heaven will be a place of serving Jesus. We will have work to do in eternity—not boring drudgery, but exciting, satisfying work. Revelation 22:3 tells us, "The throne of God and of the Lamb will be in the city, and his servants will serve him." In our transformed resurrection bodies, we will serve Him in ways we can't even imagine now.

In your research, what did you learn about Heaven that surprised you the most?

MY: I think the most surprising fact about Heaven, for most Christians, is that the Bible speaks not just of one Heaven, but of three Heavens—and a fourth Heaven that is yet to come.

People are often shocked when I tell them that the First Heaven is not where God is. The First Heaven is the domain of Satan. Paul wrote in Ephesians 6:12: "For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms." So, the First Heaven is the invisible spiritual realm that interpenetrates the visible world in which we live. It's where Satan dwells and has authority.

The Second Heaven is the universe of the celestial heavens. Psalm 19 tells us, "The heavens declare the glory of God." This is the realm of the skies, the stars, the planets, and the far-flung galaxies.

The Third Heaven is the place the Bible calls Paradise. Remember that Jesus, during the crucifixion, told the repentant thief, "Today you will be with me in Paradise." The apostle Paul wrote that he saw Paradise, the third Heaven, and he witnessed things he was not permitted to speak of. This is where all believers go when they die, and it is where Jesus is right now, interceding for us with God the Father.

Could you share a lesser-known aspect of heaven that you explore in your book and its relevance to contemporary Christian theology?

MY: I find that few Christians really understand that the present Heaven, or Paradise, is not our eternal destination. There is another Heaven that is yet to come. When the new Heaven comes—the eternal home that Jesus has promised us—the old Heaven will be rolled away. Revelation 21:1 tells us, "Then I saw 'a new heaven and a new earth,' for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away."

In John 14, Jesus describes this new Heaven as a place with "many rooms," a place that He is preparing for us as our eternal

home. How big are those "rooms" in the new Heaven? Revelation 21 actually gives us the measurements of our future home, and the volume of the new Heaven works out to about 2.75 billion cubic miles. If the new Heaven housed 100 billion people, every one of them could have a cube-shaped "room" measuring 75 acres per side.

What would you say to those who may doubt or question the existence of Heaven?

MY: First, I would encourage people to avoid the sensational "Heaven tourism" books that

have been published in recent years—books about people who say they died and visited Heaven then returned to earth. I'm not saying these books are all fraudulent. But I do know this: God doesn't make mistakes. Hebrews 9:27 says, "People are destined to die once, and after that to face judgment."

Only three people in history have been confirmed as receiving a glimpse of Heaven in this life: The martyr Stephen had a glimpse of Heaven moments before his death. The apostle Paul had a vision of the Third Heaven—but he was forbidden to speak of what he saw. And John saw Heaven in a vision on the Island of Patmos, then he wrote about it in the Book of Revelation. God gave these three men glimpses of Heaven for special reasons at a special time in history.
